## How To Open Your Safe

There are 2 marks located on your combination dial. You will be dialing your personal combination numbers to the mark that is **straight up**, not the slanted mark.

*First*, turn the dial to the **left** counter-clockwise **four** times and stop on your first combination number \_\_\_\_\_.

*Second*, now that you have already set in your first number, slowly turn the dial to the **right** (clockwise), passing your **second** number \_\_\_\_\_ two times and landing on it the 3<sup>rd</sup> time you come to it.

*Third*, turn the dial slowly to the **left** (counter-clockwise) passing your **third** number \_\_\_\_\_ once and stopping on it the 2<sup>nd</sup> time you come to it.

*Finally*, turn the dial slowly to the **right** (clockwise). The dial will **stop** on or about your last number \_\_\_\_\_. Do not force the dial if it does not stop. Once it stops, carefully turn the safe handle and open up the safe. If it does not stop, start process over again. Do not become discouraged if you don't get it the first time. Remember, it is set on a 4-3-2-1 system, going left-right-left-right to open.

If you should have any problems with the combination and can not get it open after multiple tries, call us at (760) 746-1016 Monday-Friday 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM Pacific Standard Time.

### Warning

It's very important to turn the dial slowly and methodically. The smoother you turn the dial the better it will work, and the longer it will last. Spinning the dial rapidly can cause the combination to slip. Spinning the dial will also prematurely wear out the lock. Problems caused by misuse will not be covered by the factory warranty.
